Definitions and Terms

Collaborative decision-making = is a situation faced when individuals collectively make a choice from the alternatives before them. The *decision* is then no longer attributable to any single individual who is a member of the group.

Stewardship = the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care.

Cumulative effects = are changes to the environment that are caused by an action in combination with other past, present and future human actions.

Government-to-government = Indigenous governments have the authority under existing Canadian law to exercise jurisdiction. First Nations hold real authority and substantial bargaining power in their dealings with the federal and provincial governments.
